

ID Requirements

A NOCN candidate must provide a form of Primary ID containing a photograph and signature.

If they do not have the required form of Primary ID they may present two forms of Secondary ID. This must be ID from **List A** and ID from **List B** (two from List A or two from List B is not acceptable)

Candidates who are not able to provide the correct ID on arrival at the test centre will be turned away and will lose their test fee.

Please note:

The first and last name that the candidate uses to register must match exactly the first and last name on both of the IDs that are presented on test day.

Candidate is required to present two forms of *Original* (no photo copies or digital IDs), *valid* (not expired) IDs; one form as a Primary ID (government issued with name, recent recognisable photo, and signature) and one form as a Secondary ID (with at least a name and signature, or name and recent recognisable photo).
